## Weather & First Aid

- It's summer – be prepared for HOT weather. Wear sun screen and stay hydrated
- Leaderboards and scoreboards will display “Weather Warning” signs prior to inclement weather moving into the area. In all circumstances especially when a horn sounds avoid the following areas: open areas, hilltops, high places, isolated trees, golf carts, wire fences.
- In the event of an on course injury or emergency, contact the nearest marshal who will be able to help direct you to First Aid.

## Dress Code

- TAN – shorts, pants, capris, skirt, skort. Now for the mandatory word about appropriateness – no “Daisy Dukes”, nothing too short, or too tight. If the Jamie Farr leaders find your attire inappropriate, we will ask you to go home and change.
- Jamie Farr/AWBB T-shirt which we will give you today
- Jamie Farr hat/visor
- Footwear – tennis shoes, golf shoes (no spikes), sandals. Comfort is important, but NO flip flops

## Course Etiquette

- Obey the Marshalls! When they raise their hands (with or without quiet signs), a player is setting up – STOP moving and be quiet
- Keep your cell on SILENT
- Watch for play – stop and wait for the players to finish their shots. Err on the side of caution – if you're unsure if your actions will disturb a golfer, wait.
- Informal training available on Monday through Wednesday 10-3. If you are not familiar with golf or want to learn the course during practice sessions, come out for informal lessons about course navigation.

## Food Service

- Water Monday through Sunday at the Volunteer Tent
- Fruit, donuts, bagels, chips, Pizza, soda – Thursday through Sunday at the Volunteer Tent
  - Volunteers Monday – Wednesday be prepared to either pack a meal or purchase from on-course vendors or step out to a local establishment

## Things to bring

- Sunscreen
- Work Gloves – we'll have plastic gloves for you, but you might find work gloves easier
- Hand sanitizer – we'll have some on our carts, but think about having some on your own cart
- Small cooler (Playmate sized)– the Jamie Farr provides water at the volunteer tent, but it's handy to have a small cooler on your cart to keep extra water on hand
- Cell phone (on silent) – we'll use cell phones for on-course communications. While they're officially forbidden, we have permission to use them discreetly for on-course text communication. Silently. However, ALL cameras and photos are forbidden by the LPGA, so please don't use your phone or other camera to take pictures.

## Parking – see Parking sheet

- Park in the volunteer lot at Brint & Centennial (Lot B)
- Display your volunteer parking pass to enter free
- Shuttle buses run from the parking lot to the course, so plan on 30-minutes to get from the lot to the volunteer tent. (Arrive about 15 - 30 minutes before your shift)
